Request a property report and vegetation maps

A property report provides property information and maps to help you identify <u>clearing</u> <u>requirements (https://www.qld.gov.au/environment/land/management/vegetation/clearing)</u> and <u>available clearing options</u> (<u>https://www.qld.gov.au/environment/land/management/vegetation/clearing-options)</u>. The report will be emailed to you as a PDF, free of charge.

Property report contents

The following maps are available in the vegetation management report:

- Regulated vegetation management maps show vegetation categories needed to determine clearing requirements. Maps are generally updated monthly to show new property maps of assessable vegetation (<u>https://www.qld.gov.au/environment/land/management/vegetation/maps/mapcorrection</u>).
- Vegetation management supporting map provides information on regional ecosystems, wetlands, watercourses, and essential habitat and factors.
- Protected plants flora survey trigger map is needed to determine if any part of the proposed clearing is within a high risk area (https://environment.des.qld.gov.au/licences-permits/plants-animals/protected-plants/map-request.php).
- Koala habitat areas and koala priority areas map is needed to determine if any part of the proposed clearing is within a Koala Priority Area or Koala Habitat Area.

Viewing maps on Queensland Globe

The regulated vegetation management maps and the vegetation management supporting map can also be viewed through <u>Queensland Globe</u>

(https://www.business.qld.gov.au/business/support-tools-grants/services/mapping-dataimagery/queensland-globe). After you've accessed the Globe:

- 1. Zoom in to the area of interest on the map or use the search function.
- 2. On the left-hand side of the screen, click Layers. An All Layers panel will appear.
- 3. At the top of the panel, click Add layers.
- 4. Click the down arrow next to Biota (Flora & Fauna) to expand that layer.
- 5. Select Vegetation management information.
- 6. Select the map/s you want to display.
